Day 1 Saturday 2nd October 2010

HAMILTON – NORFOLK ISLAND

Departing our office we are transferred to the Auckland International Airport to check in for our international flight to Norfolk Island. Upon our arrival we clear customs formalities and are transferred to our accommodation for the next 7 nights at the South Pacific Resort Hotel. Time to relax and maybe a 'power nap' after our early start and the chance to familiarise yourself with your surroundings. Dinner tonight at the hotel.

Day 2 Sunday 3rd October 2010

ORIENTATION TOUR AND FLETCHERS FATE MYSTERY DINNER

(BD)

This morning we will enjoy a half day *orientation tour of the island*. Visit historic Kingston, Cascade, Longridge & much more. See & hear about the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches & golf course, the renowned Melanesian Chapel, our Government, our laws & lifestyle. Enjoy views from Queen Elizabeth Lookout & other scenic spots on this full commentary conducted tour. Rest for delicious morning tea in the garden of an historic Island home built by descendant of 'Bounty' mutineers Fletcher Christian & Matthew Quintal. Free time this afternoon before venturing out again in the early evening. Tonight we enjoy '*Fletchers Fate Mystery Dinner*' - A fascinating evening of interactive theatre, intrigue & mystery. This entertaining play, examining the possible last movements & final whereabouts of the famous mutineer, Fletcher Christian, is dramatically acted out by a character cast over a sumptuous 3 course dinner.

Day 3 Monday 4th October 2010

NORFOLK INDULGENCE TOUR & PROGRESSIVE DINNER TO ISLAND HOMES (BD)

This morning is at leisure. This afternoon we *enjoy the Norfolk Indulgence Tour*. This tour visits the local Chocolate Shop for a demonstration of how they make chocolate on the Island as well as sampling the results! Next we visit a liqueur factory for a tasting of the different local liqueurs on the Island. We finish the tour with cheese and crackers atop Mt Pitt to enjoy the 360 views of the Island. This evening we *get out and meet the locals in their homes on a progressive dinner*. Enjoy a **4 course meal** progressing to different Island homes. A fun night and a good way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes

Day 4 Tuesday 5th October 2010

CONVICT SETTLEMENT TOUR & ISLAND FISH FRY & SOUND & LIGHT SHOW (BD)

This morning is at leisure. This afternoon join us on an '*In Depth*' *tour of the historic Georgian settlement of Kingston*. Walk through the cemetery & hear the history of interesting convict & colonial headstones, hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Walk through the ruins of the New Gaol, see the Pier Store, Boat Shed and the Crank Mill. Afternoon tea included. This evening we embark on the *Island Fish Fry - enjoy a feast of Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by Island desserts and tea/coffee*. Watch the sunset over the ocean from Puppy's Point on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline. Following dinner we enjoy the *Sound and Light Show*. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the convict settlement. The stillness of the sea beneath the stars is there just as it was before mankind arrived in 1788. However, with dramatic use of real life sounds together with theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as we are taken through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 5 Wednesday 6th October 2010

BREAKFAST BUSH WALK, CHRISTIANS 4WD TOUR & WONDERLAND BY NIGHT (BD)

Take your choice of a stroll through One Hundred Acres Reserve or for the more energetic, **a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument**. At the end of both walks we meet on the clifftop for a **delicious breakfast barbecue**. When we return from our morning walk there is time out in the village to sample some of the shopping the Norfolk Island is Famous for. Join John and his staff – all direct descendants of the Bounty Mutineers, on an exciting **three-hour tour to points of Norfolk only accessible to 4WD**. This back of beyond tour takes you through private properties and the national park featuring spectacular scenery, native flora and bird life. It also includes delicious home made cakes with tea and coffee at a beautiful island home. Don't expect a rough race through the scrub. Drivers are considerate and very knowledgeable. **All vehicles are comfortable modern 4WD's**. Dinner tonight is at our hotel. **This evening we head out for the Wonderland by Night tour**. The setting is 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines & bushland lit up like an enchanted forest. Meander along (or ride in the 'moon buggy') a winding pathway with Archie, a descendant of the Bounty mutineers, as he recites his poems and lights up the dioramas. Then afterward enjoy a light supper.

Day 6 Thursday 7th October 2010

HORSE & CARRIAGE TOUR & MUTINY ON THE BOUNTY SHOW (BD)

For the highlight of your Norfolk holiday **Culla & his Clydesdales take us tripping where cars can't go** on the "Steeles Point Carousel Horse & Carriage Tour" and see Norfolk's countryside at a leisurely pace. Culla, a true local identity descended from the Buffett clan, started Culla & Co in 1986 when he imported his first Clydesdale, Frodo from New Zealand. From the time you leave the Coach House in Rooty Hill Road till you return two hours later you will be regaled with tales of Island life in true Culla style - a treat in itself! Morning tea is served out on private property overlooking the ocean at Steeles Point. This afternoon is yours to enjoy. We have dinner at the hotel before going out to enjoy one of Norfolk Island's most popular visitor attractions – **the Mutiny on the Bounty Show**, a dramatic production involving scores of Islanders. See descendants of the mutineers bring their story and historic events alive in a 90-minute realistic portrayal staged in an outdoor amphitheatre on the Island's western shoreline.

Day 7 Friday 8th October 2010

GLASS BOTTOM BOAT CRUISE & A NIGHT AS A CONVICT (BD)

Today we enjoy a **cruise on Christians Glaas Bohtom Boets (Glass Bottom Boats)**. Norfolk Island has extensive but little-known coral reefs which today we will enjoy without getting wet on our glass-bottom boat tour. This afternoon is time out to get your last minute shopping done or relax at our accommodation. Tonight is a fun night out for all ages! **Dress as a convict & join with the commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing & dancing** (outfit supplied). Great food! Great fun! This is the most popular feature dinner on Norfolk.

Day 8 Saturday 9th October 2010
