Departing yard at 8:00am

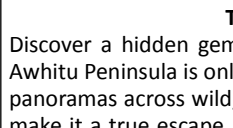

Tuesday 3 October 2017 - Highways & Byways "Waterview Tunnel"



The Waterview Tunnel is a key piece of the Western Ring Route, a 48km motorway route through the west of Auckland, connecting Manukau, the city, West Auckland and the North Shore. The 2.4km Waterview Tunnel between Pt Chevalier and Mt Roskill opened in July 2017, and cost \$1.4b to build. Today we will ride on this new section of motorway, before stopping in Auckland to purchase some lunch and browse the shops.

Thursday 26 October 2017 - Piha

Piha is one of, if not THE most famous beach in New Zealand. It is renowned for its superb scenic beauty and its surf. Piha has black iron sand swept up the coast from the entrance to the Waikato River, the sand produced by the eruption of Taupo eons ago. It is a small bay, with large remnant volcanic rocky islands to south and north. The southern end of Piha beach is guarded by Taitomo Island or Camel Rock, and farther south, The Gap. The northern end of the beach is guarded by Lion Rock or Whakaari. *Please note that today's trip is limited to a maximum of 18 passengers, so book quickly to avoid missing out!*

This beautiful lake and forest is part of the Tongariro National Park and World Heritage Area. 5km loop walk, 2 hour return. Bring a picnic lunch with you on this day. *A reasonable level of fitness is required for this trip.*

6 days - 48 hours prior to trip receives a 50% refund.

Less than 48 hours prior to trip no refund.

Please note our Terms and Conditions for Concert Connections:

- Payments must be received within a week of booking.
- Payments for show connections are final and non-refundable.
- Bookings on show connections are transferrable, therefore if for any reason the original passenger booked cannot travel it becomes his/her responsibility to find a replacement, and to notify Leisure Time Tours of any changes.
- If it is requested of Leisure Time Tours to find a replacement then a handling fee may be charged which would be deducted from any refund payable if a replacement is successfully found.
